Dear Residents and Families:

I can't believe I am sending out a letter to everyone regarding a new mask mandate that was put in place this morning for all of Erie County. Yesterday, Erie County Executive, Mark Poloncarz announced that—because of the rising number of positive COVID cases and hospitalizations—masks are mandatory in all public areas. If our numbers don't improve in our county, the County Executive put a four phase process in place with the last phase entailing shutdowns.

While many residents think that Asbury is not a public place and the mask mandate doesn't pertain to us, it unfortunately does. Your home is your apartment and the common areas in the building are considered public.

Starting tomorrow, November 24th, all visitors and residents in any of the common areas of Asbury Pointe must wear a face mask. I know this is upsetting to many residents, but if Erie County numbers don't improve, we could potentially have to shut down the dining rooms and have no visitors in the building again. Wearing a mask is a small step to avoid having further restrictions in the future.
