Dear Residents and Families,


Well we made it to 2022!! I hope everyone enjoyed spending time with their loved ones and enjoyed the beautiful holiday season.

As everyone is aware, the new omicron variant is out there and it is extremely contagious. The new variant is causing our numbers in this area to rise daily. Currently, we are maintaining a rolling average of over 17% positivity rate in Erie County as of 1/1/2022. The effects of the holiday gatherings have not completely impacted our numbers yet. The projection is that our numbers of positive COVID cases will only continue to go up.

In December, we had a large number of visitors in the building using our dining rooms with larger numbers using our *private* dining room. When residents and visitors are sitting in the dining room eating, they are not masked which increases the risk of transmission of COVID. With your safety as our number one priority, starting tomorrow, January 4<sup>th</sup> we are suspending guests in our dining rooms. If you are having guests in, you may order and have the meal delivered to your apartment.

We have been extremely fortunate that we have had no positive cases of COVID in the building. Please be patient and cooperative with this new restriction. In taking this proactive step, it is our hope that we will not have to put any more restrictions in place.
