

Dear Residents and Families:

The Erie County Health Department is reporting rising Covid-19 cases in this area, and the CDC reports Erie County at a *high* Covid-19 community level. The Department of Health is recommending wearing face masks indoors in public settings. Therefore, in order to keep our community safe, starting tomorrow—Tuesday, 4/26—all residents, staff and visitors are required to wear face masks (covering the nose and mouth) while in Asbury Pointe's indoor public spaces (anywhere in the building outside of your own apartment). Masks may be taken off once you are seated in the dining rooms.

It is our hope that this small step will deter any further restrictions.
