## Beechwood Receives New York State Award

Nominated by Aspire of WNY, Beechwood Continuing Care received an award for employing persons of disabilities from the WNY Employment Consortium and the NYS Office of Adult Career and Continuing Education Services – Vocational Rehabilitation (ACCES-VR).

Beechwood houses a number of non-paid internships for local high school students through a unique vocational program called Project SEARCH of WNY. Although an international model, Project Search is a one-of-its-kind program in the Buffalo area with Beechwood serving as its business liaison and primary employer. Beechwood Continuing Care employs several graduates of Project SEARCH of WNY. As of this nomination, there are many individuals that were offered paid employment positions by various departments within Beechwood. Supervisors are open to working with Employment Specialists/Job Coaches to collaborate to ensure individuals with disabilities have the best on the job experience possible.
