

Nursing Home Disclosure Requirements

The New York State public health law is amended by adding a new section 2829 that addresses nursing home disclosure requirements effective 10/21/2021.

1. Beechwood Homes is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization licensed in New York State. As such, it has no owners.
2. There is no landlord on the Beechwood Homes premises.
3. Beechwood Homes routinely reviews and screens vendors/contracts/agreements for the provision of goods or services for which the facility pays with any portion of Medicaid or Medicare funds. The facility utilizes Kinney Services Inc. (KSI) Kchecks© system which allows us to automatically search a central repository on a monthly basis for individuals and entities that have been excluded from participating in federally funded healthcare programs which include Medicare and Medicaid. This insures that our vendors/contracts/agreements are appropriate to participate and be paid with funds received from Medicare and Medicaid. Some specific examples would be: A. The Medicare Managed Care Plans – IHA, BCBS, & Univera; B. LTC Pharmacy – Buffalo Pharmacy; C. Fire Systems and Prevention – Davis Ulmer. 4. The facility rates for residency and services for non-governmental payer source range from \$199.00/day - \$592.25/day, which includes all applicable NYS taxes.
