Dear Family Members/Responsible Parties:

I want to provide a brief COVID update for everyone at this time. The current resident cases on Hope, Trinity, and Pines house are recovering and responding well to the antiviral treatments. I anticipate that they will recover fully next week. In addition, all of the follow-up surveillance testing of the residents on all four (4) households was completed and all resident tests were negative. However, we did have two (2) new staff cases yesterday with one (1) a direct care staff from one (1) of the households. All remaining staff tested negative. All of the residents and families were update accordingly—both the positive and negative results.

The facility remains diligent with performing disinfecting & sanitizing procedures in the resident spaces as a precaution and I encourage all family members to exercise additional caution with visitation. If you feel sick or have any mild symptoms, please consider staying home for a day or so to recover and don't risk passing the virus to your loved one and potentially other residents & staff. Further, please adhere to the infection prevention & control protocols while you visit—wear your mask properly and at all times, socially distance, and avoid unnecessary contact with others beyond your family member.
