Over the last three years, in spite of the COVID pandemic, Beechwood Continuing Care (BCC) has strategically amended its business model and service line to better address the future residential and health care needs of Western New York.

In addition to the unique independent living experience at Asbury Pointe in Getzville, BCC is now proud to provide independent living on the Presbyterian Village at North Church campus in the Town of Amherst, and at the Ken-Ton Presbyterian Village senior apartments in the Town of Tonawanda. Consistent with our commitment to nurturing each individual's quality of life by honoring personal values in a supportive environment, residents may make personal arrangements to receive home care services in the privacy of their own apartment.

The growing popularity and use of home care services is a trend occurring in New York State and across the country. After aging later in life with the support of home care, many seniors are no longer interested in or appropriate for placement at the traditional assisted living level of care. Therefore designated space on the Beechwood campus in Getzville has been redesigned to create the quality living experience of a traditional assisted living setting – with the added benefit of providing onsite access to additional nursing and medical services personnel as needed.

Enthusiasm and anticipation remain strong to redevelop Blocher Homes with People Inc. – Western New York's leading non-profit human services agency – to mixed-income apartment living in the Village of Williamsville. Plans for repurposing Lockport Presbyterian Home Assisted Living include the development of market-rate apartments as well. Apartments sorely needed in Niagara County. Upon completion, these apartments will help bring the City of Lockport into compliance with Governor Hochul's recently announced New York Housing Compact Plan for all municipalities statewide.
